REQUEST FOR REALLOCATION OF GRANT FUNDS WITH RESPECT TO THE DEEPWATER HORIZON INCIDENT: ELECTRICAL SERVICE, ACCESS FROM ADJACENT STREET, LOADING/PARKING AREA AND SOIL STABILIZATION/EROSION CONTROL FOR STORAGE BUILDING CONTAINING RESPONSE MATERIALS/SUPPLIES RELATED TO THE DEEPWATER HORIZON INCIDENT

WHEREAS, the Town was granted funds in May, 2010 by the Alabama Emergency Management Agency "to prevent, minimize or mitigate the damage from the Deepwater Horizon Incident including any project management costs and equipment costs associated therewith"; and

WHEREAS, there remain funds that have not been liquidated pursuant to the original project application and grant agreement; and

WHEREAS, Alabama EMA has sent to the Town a Reallocation Project Application Form and Agreement to be used for requests to reallocate remaining grant funds to pay or otherwise cover costs related to the Deepwater Horizon Incident; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to add electrical service, access from adjacent street, loading/parking area and soil stabilization/erosion control to the existing storage building which houses mitigation response materials and supplies related to the Deepwater Horizon Incident; and

WHEREAS, the additions will improve the usability of the building, prevent erosion of the surrounding soils and provide easy access to the building for rapid deployment of boom in case of a local or regional oil spill.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Perdido Beach, Alabama, in regular session and under the Seal of the Town of Perdido Beach, Alabama, does hereby request approval from the Alabama EMA for reallocation of funds that have not been liquidated pursuant to the original project application to pay or otherwise cover costs for electrical service, access from adjacent street, loading/parking area and soil stabilization/erosion control for the storage building containing response materials and supplies related to the Deepwater Horizon Incident.
