WHEREAS, It has been suggested that the community town meeting facility be named after Mr. Al Thompson, a longtime resident of Perdido Beach, born March 26, 1936, departed this life on November 21, 2014, and


WHEREAS, Al was a 20 year veteran of the United States Army and had a longtime career in site construction as well as other business endeavors, and long time involvement in County and local government, and

WHEREAS, Al's love for his community was evident through his service in the Perdido Beach Volunteer Fire Dept., the Town incorporation effort and service as a Town Council Member, dedicated to preserving Perdido Beach's small town charm, and

WHEREAS, Al had a passion for preserving public rights, that included keeping public water accesses open for all and for the betterment of the Community, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PERDIDO BEACH, ALABAMA that the PERDIDO BEACH COMMUNITY BUILDING be named after "Rhoe A "Al" Thompson in honor of his dedicated service to the citizens of Perdido Beach.
