Mayor Parker reported on work being performed on the town's streets to repair damage as a result of the April flood. She reported that Volkert, Inc. has started the engineering work on Riggs St. which should be finished in approximately three months. She also reported that repair work to the other streets will begin soon, under a contract awarded to Gene's Dozer.

Mayor's Update on Trip to Washington, D.C.

Mayor Parker reported that the Presidential Task Force on Climate Preparedness and Resilience met at the White House on July 16, 2014. This was the fourth and last meeting scheduled for the task force. President Obama joined the task force for a portion of the meeting and sends his regards to the citizens of Perdido Beach. A draft of the task force recommendations is due for completion by the first of November.
