**ITEM: PROPOSED RESOLUTION 2015-\_\_ IMPOSING TEMPORARY SAFETY MEASURES FOR PUBLIC USE ON ESCAMBIA AVENUE (SELMA AVENUE) WATER ACCESS.**

Mayor Parker explained the purpose of the Emergency Meeting. She gave the Council background information about a resident's claims concerning incidents happening on his property that adjoins Escambia Avenue.

There was Council Discussion:

Council Members received a copy of Section 68-Alabama League of Municipalities, Selected Readings. Streets, Alleys and Sidewalks. ***Duty of Municipalities***

The Mayor asked the Council to consider some options for addressing the resident's concerns. Discussion:

Council agreed that due to the increased usage of the Escambia Avenue water access certain conditions may have developed that present public safety concerns.

The Mayor then asked each Council Member if they felt any immediate action should be taken during the Emergency meeting that would alleviate any conditions that may be a safety issue. Each Council Member responded and it was agreed that no immediate action should be taken.

Discussion moving forward with safety measures at water accesses will be continued at the next Council Meeting.

There was Council discussion regarding hiring a Sheriff Deputy for the Memorial Day weekend. Mayor Parker asked each Council Member to approve the funds to pay a Deputy Sheriff on a temporary basis for the Memorial Day Weekend.




Mayor Parker, by way of announcement gave the Council a report from the Alabama League of Municipalities on House Bill # 185 and Senate Bill # 237.

Resolution 2015-\_\_\_\_\_ IMPOSING TEMPORARY SAFETY MEASURES FOR PUBLIC  
USE ON ESCAMBIA AVENUE (SELMA AVENUE) WATER ACCESS

WHEREAS, Escambia Avenue (originally Selma Avenue) is a water access street platted in 1900 and recorded in Baldwin County Probate Deed Book 3, pp 300-301, intersecting with Bay Street on Perdido Bay (maps attached); and

WHEREAS, Escambia Avenue is a water access street within the corporate limits of The Town of Perdido Beach, Alabama, the governmental entity responsible for its maintenance and for public safety; and

WHEREAS, being a water access street historically used by the public to access the waters of Perdido Bay, which use has dramatically increased with the passage of time, certain conditions have developed that present public safety concerns, primarily due to weekend overcrowding.

THEREFORE, with the intent of reducing the overcrowding, be it resolved that from this date forward until September 15, 2015 or until other solutions are adopted by the Town Council, signs reading "no parking" will be erected on Escambia Avenue Water Access.
