Town of Perdido Beach Property

Rezone R-1, Single Family District to OR, Outdoor Recreation District

The subject property is currently zoned R-1, Single Family District, and is unoccupied. The requested designation is OR, Outdoor Recreation District. According to the submitted information, the purpose of this request is to allow for a public pier with parking and to provide access to a proposed public boat launch at the end of the State Street right of way.

The Town of Perdido Planning Commission considered this request at its June 7, 2017 meeting and voted to Recommend APPROVAL to the Town Council.

\*On rezoning applications, the Town Council will have the final decision.

Mrs. Lee-Baldwin County Planner presented the rezoning case with a power point presentation.
