### **Budget and Finance Meeting Report**

### **Town Council Meeting**

### February 13, 2020

Our committee met February 11<sup>th</sup> and reviewed the various financial reports to ensure expenditures are in line with the budget and the bank accounts for accuracy. Income and expenses seem to be in line with the Budget for the month of January with income being \$22,879.37 more than expenses. This being the time of year everyone pays their property taxes, income for the month of January appears very strong. Budgeted items are all in line, with Simplesell Tax being much better than the budgeted amount. The new rebuild Alabama Gas Tax is running between \$800 and \$900 per month and is earmarked for street repair.

The General Fund had \$378,894.00 in it as of 1/31/2020. This number is like your checking account and varies daily. We have to always remain mindful of Budget constraints when considering which new projects to fund.

The special BP account has \$119,201.18 left in it which represents the money remaining to be spent on the State Street Park. The special BP checking account has \$12,414.86 remaining in it as of 1/31/20. See attached sheet for Capital improvement and Gas tax account balances.

Our finances for the fourth month of this fiscal year appear to be strong. Again income is above the projected Budget and expenses are below Budget projections. The unbudgeted repair of the damage on the Bay Avenue right of way is ongoing and we should have a total to report at the March meeting. The Town is on good financial footing at this point.

## RESOLUTION 2020-02 APPROVING FUNDS TO PERFORM NON-BID WORK FOR THE TOWN OF PERDIDO BEACH

WHEREAS, Section 11-43-56, Code of Alabama 1975, states: Management and control of finances and property of municipality. Except as otherwise provided, the council shall have the management and control of the finances and all the property, real and personal, belonging to the city or town; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-47-5, Code of Alabama 1975, states: Execution of contracts. Contracts entered into by a municipality shall be in writing, signed and executed in the name of the city or town by the officers authorized to make the same and by the party contracting. In cases not otherwise directed by law or ordinance, such contracts shall be entered into and executed by the mayor in the name of the city or town and all obligations for the payment of money by the municipality, except for bonds and interest coupons, shall be attested by the clerk. This section shall not be construed to cover purchases for the ordinary needs of the municipality.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council does hereby approve funds to be paid from the General fund to perform non-bid work for the Town, specifically, for the construction of a step system over a section of the rip-rap installed for shoreline protection at Escambia Avenue to the water's edge of Perdido Bay, thus providing a walkway to the water. The Town Council does hereby award contract to MG Marine in the amount up \$2,500.00 for the completion of said work. Any contracts associated with this approval shall be in writing, signed and executed by the Mayor in the name of the Town of Perdido Beach and all obligations for payment of compensation shall be attested by the clerk.
