Budget and Finance Meeting Report Town Council Meeting December 13, 2018

- The Committee met December 11, 2018 and is continuing to review the various financial reports to ensure expenditures are in line with the budget. Income and expenses seem to be in line for the month of November with income being \$166.45 less than expenses for the month.
 - The General Fund had \$248,825.02 in it as of 11/30/2018. This number is like your checking account and varies daily. Income is behind the budget projection for the first 2 months due to property taxes not all being in yet. Expenses are well below the Budget but will even out over time. We have to remain mindful of Budget constraints.
 - The special BP account has \$118,643.77 left in it which represents the money remaining to be spent on the State Street Park. The special BP checking account has \$24,421.47 remaining in it as of 10/31/18. Of this money \$13,162.08 is committed to remodeling of the storage building.
 - Under new business we discussed the need for a new computer and copier/printer for the Town clerk. The Mayor is looking into purchasing a computer with a service agreement and is actively looking for a suitable copier/printer that will hold up to office use.
