Discuss Recreational Vehicle Ordinance – Chairman Brown believes we can permit the use of RVs and members of the community would abide by the ordinance. Motion made by Commissioner Head; 2nd Councilwoman Koehle to maintain current ordinances 12.2.2 and 15.3, no further discussion will continue of RVs for 2023. Discussion – Chairman Brown believes people will abide by ordinance and it could be good for the Town. Vice-Chairwoman Chastain said we'd previously discussed this possibility previously and it was not liked by many in the Town. Commissioner Head believes not everyone will follow the ordinance and there potentially could be affects to property values. Commissioner McKenna stated it could possibly overload septic systems.

- Discuss Tree Ordinance Three trees were chosen as candidates for protection. Longleaf Pine, Live Oak, and Southern Magnolia were chosen. Councilwoman Koehle will present to Council the Tree Ordinance discussion.
