RESOLUTION 2011-17 REQUEST FOR HAZARD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE FOR AN EMERGENCY POWER GENERATOR UNDER INCIDENT FEMA-1971-DR-AL

WHEREAS, in the early morning hours of April 27, 2011, tornadoes, severe thunderstorms, hail and straight line winds began moving across the northern portion of Alabama, followed by a second wave which involved numerous super-cell thunderstorms producing long lived, strong to violent tornadoes across the northern two-thirds of central Alabama; and

WHEREAS, after assessment of storm damage resulting from the severe weather activity, an Emergency Declaration was issued for all 67 counties of the State of Alabama, specifically authorized to provide emergency protective measures limited to direct federal assistance, under Public Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the FEMA-1971-DR-AL application period for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) is open and applications are being accepted; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Perdido Beach, Alabama, is in need of an emergency power generator at town hall and is eligible to submit an application.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council does hereby submit a request under FEMA-1971-DR-AL to Alabama Emergency Management Agency (AEMA) for funds to purchase and install an emergency power generator to be located at Town Hall, 9212 County Road 97, Perdido Beach, Alabama.
