
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MR. THOMAS TOOMBS FOR THE PLACEMENT OF RIP RAP ROCKS ACROSS A PORTION OF BAY STREET AT WATER'S EDGE FOR EROSION CONTROL


WHEREAS, Section 11-43-56, Code of Alabama 1975, states: **Management and control of finances and property of municipality.** Except as otherwise provided in the title, the council shall have the management and control of the finances and all the property, real and personal, belonging to the city or town; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-47-5, Code of Alabama 1975, states: **Execution of contracts.** Contracts entered into by a municipality shall be in writing, signed and executed in the name of the city or town by the officers authorized to make the same and by the party contracting. In cases not otherwise directed by law or ordinance, such contracts shall be entered into and executed by the mayor in the name of the city or town and all obligations for the payment of money by the municipality, except for bonds and interest coupons, shall be attested by the clerk. This section shall not be construed to cover purchases for the ordinary needs of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the governing body of the Town of Perdido Beach that the Mayor is authorized to negotiate and enter into a contract with Mr. Toombs for the placement of rip rap rocks across a portion of Bay Street at water's edge for erosion control. No ownership or right of control over Bay Street shall be impacted by said contract and all materials and real property rights shall remain under the ownership and control of the Town. Council hereby finds that said public private partnership serves a public purpose and is in the best interest of the Town to help control the erosion of its bay front streets.
