

## RESOLUTION 2022-02 APRROVING THE ORIENTATION OF THE STATE STREET BOAT RAMP AND FUNDS FOR REQUIRED PERMITS

WHEREAS, Section 11-43-56, Code of Alabama 1975; Management and control of finances and property of municipality. Except as otherwise provided, the council shall have the management and control of the finances and all the property, real and personal, belonging to the city or town; and

Whereas, the Town of Perdido Beach has approved constructing a public boat launch, finger pier, access road, and parking lot on a tract of land owned by the town, which is located between Tuscaloosa Dr. and Soldier Creek and within the State St. right of way.

Whereas, Heather Reed Moore, Natural Resource Specialist/Project Manager with Ecological Consulting Services presented to the Town Council and members of the town that were present on December 16, 2021, during a Special Council Meeting a revised drawing changing the orientation of the boat ramp for said boat launch facility.

Whereas, in order to move forward with this project, approval of the revised orientation of the boat ramp is needed to acquire new permits, as the original permits have expired.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Town Council does hereby approve the proposed orientation of the boat ramp and hereby authorizes Mayor Hamilton to proceed, with an estimated amount of \$3,600.00 for fees and permitting for the public boat launch facility on the property located between Tuscaloosa Dr. and Soldier Creek and along the side of State St. right of way. County parcel #63-18-0-001.000 (ppin 011210).
