RESOLUTION 2022-03 APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM  
“AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS” FOR COMPLETION OF  
A PUBLIC PARK AT STATE STREET

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-43-56, Code of Alabama 1975, states: **Management and control of finances and property of municipality.** Except as otherwise provided, the council shall have the management and control of the finances and all the property, real and personal, belonging to the city or town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Perdido Beach and its citizens have suffered greatly from the effects of the COVID Pandemic

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Perdido Beach were asked to quarantine and shelter in place numerous times during the Pandemic

**WHEREAS**, the citizens were subjected to social and physical isolation from others

**WHEREAS**, this will provide a safe outdoor location for citizens to enjoy, alleviating some of the stress caused by the Pandemic, contributing to the health and wellbeing of The Town of Perdido Beach

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Council does hereby approve the use of these funds in the amount of \$73,275.00 to complete the State Street Park located between Tuscaloosa Street and Soldiers Creek
