**RESOLUTION 2011-01**

**MANAGEMENT OF BOOM, SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS ASSOCIATED WITH PROJECTS APPROVED BY AEMA TO PREVENT, MINIMIZE OR MITIGATE DAMAGE FROM THE DEEPWATER HORIZON INCIDENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Perdido Beach, Alabama, was impacted by oil from the Deepwater Horizon Incident; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town received grant funds from Alabama Emergency Management Agency (AEMA) to prevent, minimize or mitigate the damage from the Deepwater Horizon Incident; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant includes "project management costs and equipment cost associated" with each project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grantor, AEMA, has previously approved these expenditures and they are a component of said grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has on hand boom, supplies and materials associated with projects approved by AEMA to prevent, minimize or mitigate the damage from the Deepwater Horizon Incident; and


**WHEREAS**, said boom, supplies and materials are staged outdoors where damage and deterioration will occur due to exposure to the elements; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town Council recognizes the need to manage said boom, supplies and materials by providing for them a secure storage facility.

**THEREFORE**, the Town Council approves associated "management costs" (as outlined in the grant projects) necessary to construct a storage facility of sufficient size and manner to contain said boom, supplies and materials.
