**RESOLUTION 2011-25**

**RATIFYING SUBMISSION OF STORAGE BUILDING UPGRADE AGREEMENT TO  
THE ALABAMA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ACCEPTING  
REALLOCATION OF GRANT FUNDS WITH RESPECT TO THE DEEPWATER  
HORIZON INCIDENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Town was granted funds in May, 2010 by the Alabama Emergency Management Agency (AEMA) "to prevent, minimize or mitigate the damage from the Deepwater Horizon Incident including any project management costs and equipment costs associated therewith"; and

**WHEREAS**, there remain funds that have not been liquidated pursuant to the original project application and grant agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, in November, 2011 the Town requested reallocation of funds remaining with respect to the Deepwater Horizon Incident to add electrical service, access from adjacent street, loading/parking area and soil stabilization/erosion control to the existing storage building which houses mitigation response materials and supplies related to the Deepwater Horizon Incident; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 1, 2011 the Town was notified by AEMA that the request had been approved and was instructed to execute two copies of the grant agreement attached to the email; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 6, 2011, two copies of the agreement were executed and mailed to Mr. Art Faulkner, Director of the Alabama Emergency Management Agency.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Council of the Town of Perdido Beach, Alabama, in regular session and under the Seal of the Town of Perdido Beach, Alabama, does hereby ratify the submission to AEMA of the "Storage Building Upgrade" agreement accepting reallocation of grant funds with respect to the Deepwater Horizon Incident.
